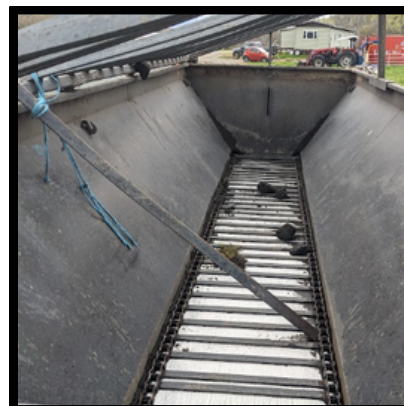


BULK MATERIAL SPREADER AVAILABLE FOR RENT

- The 8-ton bulk material spreader is available for application of lime & other soil amendments.
- This equipment is intended to support NMP & forage improvement for farm viability by enabling timely application of soil amendments to maintain productive agricultural land.

**The Orleans County Conservation District has one Bulk Material Spreader for rent.
Rented on a first come first serve basis at a rate of \$17/ac.**

The spreader can be used for application of:

- Lime - *fresh lime only: less than one year of field storage*
- Wood Ash
- Chicken Litter - *dry litter only*
- Other Similar Bulk Materials - *covered/dry only*

- Ideal for applying amendments according to soil sample results recommendations.
- Tractor requirements: approximately **100-120 HP for flat ground**, with **150+HP recommended for hills or soft field conditions**.
- A **signed rental agreement is required** prior to equipment use including reporting the estimated acreage to be spread and reporting final acreage.
- It is the responsibility of the renter to transport the spreader - at least $\frac{3}{4}$ ton truck needed
- It is the farmer's responsibility to properly operate and maintain the equipment, and to address any preventable damages and repairs.
- OCNRCDC can also provide support in identifying and accessing grant resources related to crop rotation and other associated conservation practices.
